SPECIAL FILMING CONDITIONS THE OAKS AREA (LOS FELIZ)

The Special Filming Conditions described below will be included in the terms and conditions of permits issued for filming in this area and are in addition to the standard terms and conditions applicable to filming permits generally. While these Special Filming Conditions will be included as terms if a permit for filming in this area is issued, they are not intended to, and do not, establish the criteria or standards for determining whether or not a particular permit (or permits) will be issued for this area. The decision whether or not a particular permit (or permits) will be issued is vested in the discretion of the appropriate City or County department or their designees (including FilmL.A., Inc.), to be exercised consistent with public health, safety and general welfare, and applicable land-use ordinances.

The Oaks area of Los Feliz is located north of Los Feliz Boulevard and west of Griffith Park/Ferndell Drive. The area is characterized by very narrow, steep, winding streets. There are few streets or sections that can safely accommodate equipment. It is an area that presents special filming problems. The following Special Filming Conditions have been established to address the public safety concerns raised by motion picture production activities.

- Affected residents must be notified at least two (2) days in advance of the first day of filming or the first day of any substantial set preparation. Permit requests must be submitted to FilmL.A. at least three (3) days in advance.
- Production companies must contact Susan Swan (323) 463-2463 (The Oaks HOA) sswanla@aol.com and Caroline Schweich (323) 229-0017, caroline@fizzcommunications.com at least two (2) days in advance of the first day of filming or the first day of any substantial set preparation.
- Cast and crew are not permitted to park on area streets. Off-street parking must be provided.
- Parking of production equipment is limited to one side of the street.
- Film company vehicles shall not interfere with gardeners' activities, trash pick-up, safe use of the streets or access to resident driveways, unless approved by the affected residents.
- Craft services, catering trucks, food preparation tables and dining tables are prohibited on sidewalks or parkways and must be out of public view.
- Generator(s) with the proper noise shield shall only be parked in front of the location house, or in front of houses that have approved this activity. Only tow plant generators or generators not attached to a vehicle will be allowed at location.
- Production companies may not arrive in the area prior to 7:00 a.m. and must depart no later than 10:00 p.m. unless affected residents (generally those within 300' of the filming activities or equipment parking) are surveyed to identify neighborhood concerns and approval is obtained from the Permit Authority. The approved times must be indicated on the permit.
- Cast and crew shall be informed of the provisions of the Filmmakers' Code of Professional Responsibility.

In addition to the above conditions: The following streets may pose additional challenges for film productions due to narrowness/width, cul-de-sacs and sharp curves, and may require a specific parking plan and/or utilization of stake beds and/or trucks not to exceed 20' in length:
