## ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

Through a new six-month pilot program, FilmLA and the City of Los Angeles are partnering to help filmmakers working on low impact film shoots apply for city film permits at a significantly reduced price. The program is part of an overall effort to streamline the process of film permit review, and create a fully sustainable system of tiered service pricing.

## POTENTIAL SAVINGS:

**\$931 > \$350 / APPLICATION**

A Low Impact Tier project filming for three (3) days at three (3) locations will see its out-the-door permit cost reduced by 58 percent, compared to the cost of the same activity on a Standard Tier FilmLA permit.

## WHO CAN QUALIFY:

All projects meeting program criteria are discount eligible, regardless of production type or budget size. Aligning with Mayor Karen Bass' Executive Directive 11, the program advances FilmLA's goal to encourage on-location production in the region by making permits more accessible and affordable.
